Springtide Cotton Kitchen Towel Crochet Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
 Scissors tapestry needle H, 5 mm crochet hook 3 oz -Peaches & Creme Cotton Yarn Happy Go Lucky or any worsted weight gauge 4 cotton yarn 	 ch/chs – chain/chains st/sts - stitch/stitches sc – single crochet hdc – half double crochet stitch dc – double crochet stitch

You can make a larger or smaller dish towel or a blanket by using 3 +2 chain.

Approx. 7.5 in x 7.5 in (19 cm)

Chain 26

Row 1: in the 2nd st from the hook, sc and in each st across. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 2: (*Sc, hdc, dc*) in the 1st *st*, *skip 2 *sts*, (*sc, hdc, dc*) in the next *sc*; rep from * across until 3 *sts* remain, skip the next 2 *sts*, *sc* in the last *st*. *Ch* 1 and turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have 18 rows or the length you want. End with 1 row of single crochet.

Knot and weave in ends using a tapestry needle. Cut off excess yarn. Block if you want. Enjoy
