

## Colorful Stripe Chunky Crochet Blanket Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• K– 6.5 mm crochet hook</li><li>• 10- O'Go Colorama Caron Yarn in First Blush or any bulky yarn gauge 5 yarn.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b><i>yo</i></b> – <b><i>yarn over</i></b></li><li>• <b><i>ch</i></b>– <b><i>chain</i></b></li><li>• <b><i>hdc</i></b> – <b><i>half double crochet</i></b></li><li>• <b><i>1st Feather St</i></b> – <b><i>First Feather Stitch</i></b></li><li>• <b><i>Feather St</i></b> – <b><i>Feather Stitch</i></b></li><li>• <b><i>st</i></b>– <b><i>stitch</i></b></li></ul>

Special stitch: **1st-Feather St –First Feather Stitch:** ***yo***, insert hook into the next chain space, ***yo***, pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), ***yo***, insert hook into skipped stitch/chain/chain space right below the current chain space, ***yo***, pull up a loop (5 loops on hook), ***yo***, insert hook into the next chain space, ***yo***, pull up a loop (7 loops on hook), ***yo***, pull through all 7 loops on hook.

Special stitch: **Feather Stitch** –***yo***, insert hook into the same chain space where the last leg of the previous feather was made, ***yo***, pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), ***yo***, insert hook into skipped stitch/chain/chain space right below the current chain space, ***yo***, pull up a loop (5 loops on hook), ***yo***, insert hook into the next chain space, ***yo***, pull up a loop (7 loops on hook), ***yo***, pull through all 7 loops on hook.

You can make a larger or smaller super chunky yarn blanket by using an even number for the chain.

Approx. size of blanket 40 in x 40 in (102 cm)

Chain 100

**Row 1:** ***Hdc*** in second chain from hook, \****ch*** 1, skip 1 chain, ***hdc*** in next ***ch***; repeat from \* to last chain. ***Ch*** 1, turn.

**Row 2:** ***Hdc*** in first ***hdc***, ***ch*** 1, ***1st-Feather St***, ***ch*** 1, \****Feather St***, ***ch*** 1; repeat from \* to end of row, ***hdc*** in last stitch. ***Ch*** 1, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have 110 rows or the length you want. I finished with one row of ***sc***.
