

Ribbed Double Thick Crochet Headband Pattern

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Supplies <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• H, 5 mm crochet hook• 1- 5 oz Caron Paints Yarn – in Caron Simply Soft Paints Yarn Autumn Red – or any other worsted weight gauge 4 yarn	Abbreviations – US Terms <ul style="list-style-type: none">• yo – yarn over• hdc –half double crochet• hdcb– half double crochet in the back look only
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You can make a larger or smaller headband by adding more rows or less rows in the ribbed part.

Gauge: 6 rows x 12 stitches = 3 in x 3 in (7.6 cm)

size adult -Approx. 7 in x 9.25 in (18 cm x 23.5 cm)

Chain 36

Row 1: In 2nd chain from the hook, **hdc** . Repeat across to the end. Chain 2, turn.

Row 2: In the stitch next to the chain, **hdcb**. Repeat to the end of row. Chain 2, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have 43 rows.

2nd part

Fold rectangle in half. Then evenly place 1 half double crochet stitch in each row of ribbing, making sure to go through both sides.

Row 2: Slip stitch to beginning of round. Chain 2 and **hdc** in each stitch around.

Repeat Row 2 until you have 6 rows of **hdc**. Then fold in half and whip stitch ends together including the ribbing. Cut and weave in ends.

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
