

Suzette Stitch Dishcloth Pattern

Supplies <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• H, 5 mm crochet hook• 2 oz -Peaches & Creme Cotton Yarn Happy Go Lucky or any worsted weight gauge 4 cotton yarn• 2 oz - Lily Sugar N' Cream Cotton Yarn in aqua or any worsted weight gauge 4 cotton yarn	Abbreviations – US Terms <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>ch</i>– <i>chain</i>• <i>dc</i> - <i>double crochet stitch</i>• <i>sc</i> - <i>single crochet stich</i>• <i>st</i>– <i>stitch</i>
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You can make a larger or smaller dish towel or a blanket by using an even number for the chain. I started the pattern with 1 row of single crochet.

Approx. 7 in x 7 in (18 cm)

Chain 24

Row 1: in the 2nd *st* from the hook, *sc* and in each *st* across. ***Ch*** 1 and turn.

Row 2: (*sc*, *dc*) in 1st *st*. *skip *st* (*sc*, *dc*) in *st*.* repeat from ** to the end of the row. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 3: *dc* in the 1st stitch * (*sc*, *dc*) in *sc* of the row below, repeat from * to the end of the row. Chain 1 and turn.

Final row of the suzette stitch, do two single crochets in the last stitch. Then follow with one row of single crochet.

Repeat Row 3 until you have 24 rows or the length you want.

Knot and weave in ends using a tapestry needle. Cut off excess yarn. Block if you want. Enjoy
