

## Suzette Stitch Dishcloth Pattern

<b>Supplies</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• H, 5 mm crochet hook</li><li>• 2 oz -Peaches &amp; Creme Cotton Yarn Happy Go Lucky or any worsted weight gauge 4 cotton yarn</li><li>• 2 oz - Lily Sugar N' Cream Cotton Yarn in aqua or any worsted weight gauge 4 cotton yarn</li></ul>	<b>Abbreviations – US Terms</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b><i>ch</i></b>– <b><i>chain</i></b></li><li>• <b><i>dc</i></b> - <b><i>double crochet stitch</i></b></li><li>• <b><i>sc</i></b> - <b><i>single crochet stich</i></b></li><li>• <b><i>st</i></b>– <b><i>stitch</i></b></li></ul>
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You can make a larger or smaller dish towel or a blanket by using an even number for the chain. I started the pattern with 1 row of single crochet.

Approx. 7 in x 7 in (18 cm)

Chain 24

Row 1: in the 2nd *st* from the hook, *sc* and in each *st* across. ***Ch*** 1 and turn.

Row 2: (*sc*, *dc*) in 1st *st*. \*skip *st* (*sc*, *dc*) in *st*.\* repeat from \*\* to the end of the row. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 3: *dc* in the 1st stitch \* (*sc*, *dc*) in *sc* of the row below, repeat from \* to the end of the row. Chain 1 and turn.

Final row of the suzette stitch, do two single crochets in the last stitch. Then follow with one row of single crochet.

Repeat Row 3 until you have 24 rows or the length you want.

Knot and weave in ends using a tapestry needle. Cut off excess yarn. Block if you want. Enjoy
