

Suzette Rainbow Baby Blanket Pattern

Supplies <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• H, 5 mm crochet hook• 3- 5.3 oz (150 g) Lion Brand Mandala Ombre Happy or any other worsted weight gauge 4 yarn 344 yd/315 m each	Abbreviations – US Terms <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>ch</i>– <i>chain</i>• <i>dc</i> - <i>double crochet stitch</i>• <i>sc</i> - <i>single crochet stich</i>• <i>st</i>– <i>stitch</i>

You can make a larger or smaller dish towel or a blanket by using an even number for the chain. I started the pattern with 1 row of single crochet.

Chain 108

Row 1: in the 2nd *st* from the hook, *sc* and in each *st* across. ***Ch*** 1 and turn.

Row 2: ***dc*** in 1st *st*. *skip *st* (*sc*, ***dc***) in *st*.* repeat from ** to the end of the row. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 3: dc in the 1st stitch * (sc, dc) in sc of the row below, repeat from * to the end of the row. Chain 1 and turn.

Final row of the suzette stitch, do two single crochets in the last stitch.

Repeat Row 3 until you have 102 rows or the length you want.

Knot and weave in ends using a tapestry needle. Cut off excess yarn. Block if you want. Enjoy
