

Waffle Stitch Crochet Pattern

Abbreviations – US Terms

- *ch/chs* – *chain/chains*
- *st/sts* - *stitch/stitches*
- *dc* – *double crochet stitch*
- *fpdc* - *front post double crochet stitch*

front post double crochet stitch – yarn over, insert the hook behind the post from the front across the post and through the other side, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on your hook, yo, pull thru remaining two loops on your hook. You can make a larger or smaller item by using 3 + 2 chain. The chain counts as the first double crochet of the row.

Chain a multiple of 3 + 2.

Row 1: *dc* in 4th *ch* from hook and in each *st* across, turn.

Row 2: Chain 2, **fpdc* in next *st*, *dc* in next 2 *sts*, repeat from * until the last 2 *sts*; *fpdc* in next *st*, *dc* in top of ch, turn.

Row 3: Chain 2, **dc* in next *st*, *fpdc* in the next 2 *sts*, repeat from *until the last 2 *sts*; *dc* in next *st*, *dc* in top of ch, turn.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until you have the length you want.
