

Arruga Cotton Crochet Washcloth Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• H/8, 5 mm Crochet Hook• 1 – 3 oz (85 g) Lily Sugar n Cream in Cream or any other worsted weight cotton yarn approx 150 yd/ 138 m	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• ch– chain• dc- double crochet stich• sc - single crochet stich• bpsc - back post single crochet stich• fpsc - front post single crochet stich• st– stitch

You can make a larger or smaller [dishcloth](#) or a blanket by using an even number for the chain. Turning chain counts as first stitch of the row.

Approx. 8.5 in x 8.5 in (22 cm)

chain 36 in cream

Row 1: **Dc** in 4th **ch** from hook and each **ch** across, turn.

Row 2: **ch** 1, **sc** in 1st **dc**, ***bpsc** in next **sc**, **fpsc** in next **sc**; rep from *. Repeat ** across. **sc** in top of turning chain, turn.

Row 3: **ch** 3, **dc** in each **sc** across, turn.

Row 4: **ch** 1, **sc** in 1st **dc**, ***fpsc** in next **sc**, **bpsc** in next **sc*** Repeat from ** across. **sc** in top of turning chain, turn.

Row 5: **ch** 3, **dc** in each **sc** across, turn.

Repeat Row 2-5 until you have 24 rows or a square.

Cut and knot yarn. Weave in ends, using a tapestry needle.
