## Blue Ombre Waffle Baby Blanket Crochet Pattern



Abbreviations - US Terms

- ch/chs - chain/chains
- st/sts - stitch/stitches
- dc - double crochet stitch
- fpdc - front post double crochet stitch
front post double crochet stitch - yarn over, insert the hook behind the post from the front across the post and through the other side, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on your hook, yo, pull thru remaining two loops on your hook. For more info front post double crochet stitch, from yarnspirations.com.


## Waffle Stitch How to Video

You can make a larger or smaller crocheted blanket by using $3+2$ chain. The chain counts as the first double crochet of the row.

To make a crochet waffle throw approx. 64 in x 64 in you would need 8 skeins of yarn. Start with a chain of 122 and do 68 rows.

Size: 32 in x 32 in ( 81 cm )
ch 62 in Blue
Row 1: $\boldsymbol{d} \boldsymbol{c}$ in 4th $\boldsymbol{c h}$ from hook and in each $\boldsymbol{s} \boldsymbol{t}$ across, turn.
Row 2: Chain 2, ${ }^{*} f p d c$ in next $s t, d c$ in next $2 s t s$, repeat from * until the last $2 s t s ; f p d c$ in next $\boldsymbol{s t}, \boldsymbol{d c}$ in top of ch, turn.

Row 3: Chain 2, *dc in next st, fpdc in the next 2 sts, repeat from *until the last 2 sts; dc in next st , dc in top of ch, turn.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until you have 34 rows or the length you want.
Knot end and cut yarn. Weave in yarn ends.
