

Blue Ombre Waffle Baby Blanket Crochet Pattern

Supplies <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• 10 mm crochet hook• 2- 10.5 oz (300 g) Bernat Blanket Yarn Ombre in Shaded Blue Ombre or any gauge 6 yarn 220 yd (201 m) each	Abbreviations – US Terms <ul style="list-style-type: none">• ch/chs – chain/chains• st/sts - stitch/stitches• dc – double crochet stitch• fpdc - front post double crochet stitch
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front post double crochet stitch – yarn over, insert the hook behind the post from the front across the post and through the other side, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on your hook, yo, pull thru remaining two loops on your hook. You can make a larger or smaller crocheted blanket by using 3 + 2 chain. The chain counts as the first double crochet of the row.

To make a crochet waffle throw approx. 64 in x 64 in you would need 8 skeins of yarn. Start with a chain of 122 and do 68 rows.

Size: 32 in x 32 in (81 cm)

ch 62 in Blue

Row 1: **dc** in 4th **ch** from hook and in each **st** across, turn.

Row 2: Chain 2, ***fpdc** in next **st**, **dc** in next 2 **sts**, repeat from * until the last 2 **sts**; **fpdc** in next **st**, **dc** in top of ch, turn.

Row 3: Chain 2, *dc in next st, fpdc in the next 2 sts, repeat from *until the last 2 sts; dc in next st, dc in top of ch, turn.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until you have 34 rows or the length you want.

Knot end and cut yarn. Weave in yarn ends.
