

Mini Cable Stitch Dishcloth Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• F/5 -3.75 mm crochet hook• 1- 2 oz skein of Peaches & Crème Stripey in Evening Sea or in any worsted medium weight cotton yarn	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• ch/chs – chain/chains• st/sts - stitch/stitches• sk - skip• dc - double crochet stitch• bpdc – back post double crochet stitch• fptr - front post triple crochet stitch

To make a larger or smaller project, use a multiple of 5. The chain 3 counts as the first double crochet.

ch 40 in Evening Sea

Row 1: **dc** in the 4th **ch** from the hook and **dc** in each stich across. Turn.

Row 2: **Ch** 3, **dc** in next 2 **dc**. ***Sk** next **dc**, **fptr** around next **dc**. Working in front of **st** just made, **fptr** over skipped **st**. **Dc** in next 3 **dc**. * Repeat from ** across row. Turn.

Row 3: **Ch** 3, **dc** in next 2 **dc**. **Bpdc** over next 2 **fptr**. ***Sk** next **dc**, 3 **dc** in next **dc**. **Sk** next **dc**, **bpdc** over next 2 **fptr**. * Repeat from ** until 3 **dc** left. **Dc** in last 3 **dc**. Turn.

Row 4: **Ch** 3, **dc** in next 2 **dc**. ***Sk** next **bpdc**, **fptr** in next **bpdc**. Working in front of **st** just made, **fptr** in skipped **st**. **Dc** in next 3 **dc**. * Repeat from ** across row. Turn.

Repeat Rows 3-4 for 18 rows or until you have the length you want.

Knot end and cut yarn. Weave in yarn ends.
