

### 3 Different Pumpkin Crochet Free Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Term
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• 10 mm crochet hook</li><li>• sticks for the stems</li><li>• jute cord 4 ply #72</li><li>• A small amount of Poly-fil</li><li>• 1- 5 oz (142 g) Lion Brand Hometown Yarn in Tampa Spice or any gauge 6 super bulky yarn 81 yd (74 m)</li><li>• 1- 5 oz (142 g) Lion Brand Hometown Yarn in Hoboken Honey or any gauge 6 super bulky yarn 81 yd (74 m)</li><li>• 1- 5 oz (142 g) Lion Brand Hometown Yarn in Madison Mustard or any gauge 6 super bulky yarn 81 yd (74 m)</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>ch</b> – chain</li><li>• <b>yo</b> – yarn over</li><li>• <b>sl</b> – slip stitch</li><li>• <b>sc</b> – single crochet</li><li>• <b>tr- triple crochet</b></li><li>• <b>ebc- even berry</b></li><li>• <b>st/sts- stitch/stitches</b></li></ul>

#### Small Yellow Spider Stitch Pumpkin Crochet Pattern

#### Ch 33

Row 1: 3rd chain from the hook, work one **sc**, one **ch**, one **sc**, then skip one **ch**, and work the spider again. (**sc–ch–sc**). Continue across the whole row. You should have one extra chain at the end. Work a **sc** into that stitch. **ch 2** and turn.

ROW 2: Skip over the first two stitches and find that **ch** space. You'll want to work your **sc–ch–sc** into that stitch. Continue across the row until the last stitch will be **sc**. Chain 2, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have 8 rows or the height you want.

Cut yarn and knot. Leave a long yarn tail to gather the long side.

#### How to Finish the Crochet Pumpkin

Fold the rectangle horizontally and slip or whip stitch the short ends together.

Then using a tapestry need and gather the top and bottom. Put the two ends of the piece yarn until you have closed the circle on one end.

Next, stuff the pumpkin with some fiberfill.

Make a stem out of the hemp yarn by wrapping the yarn around 4 fingers about 15 times. Then wrap the opposite direction towards one half. Cut and tie the yarn.

You can use a stick from outside or a cinnamon stick too. Another idea is to crochet a stem using yarn. I have the pattern below the 3rd pumpkin.

Insert stem in the open side and put the two ends of the yarn used to gather. Tie the two ends together when the pumpkin is gathered enough.

### How to Crochet a Red Tall Pumpkin Even Berry

**special stitch** -even berry crochet – **yo** insert your hook into the space, **yo**, pull through, **yo**, and pull through 1 loop on the hook. Then, **yo**, insert your hook into the same designated space again, **yo**, pull through, **yo**, and pull through all 5 loops on the hook.

For the even berry stitch, you need a single crochet stitch between each of the even berry stitches. You also need to alternate with a row between each of the even berry rows otherwise the texture will not be on the same side.

Ch 16

Row 1: sc in the 2nd ch from the hook and in each ch across. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 2: **sc** in the 2nd st, **ebc**, then\* **sc** in next stitch, **ebc** in next\* then repeat \* until the end of the chain. End with a **sc**. Chain 1 turn (34 st)

Row 3: **sc** in the 2nd st repeat until the end of the row chain 1 turn

Repeat rows 2-3 until you have 26 rows. Tie and cut off. Weave in ends using a tapestry.

Follow the directions above to finish pumpkin.

### How to Crochet a Tan Pumpkin Large Triple Single Stitch

Row 1: **Sc** in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain. **Sc** in each chain to the end. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 2: \*triple in the 2nd stitch, sc in the next\*, Repeat \*\* across ending with 1 sc. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 3: Sc in 2nd st and in each st across. Chain 1 and turn.

Repeat Rows 2-3 until you have 34 rows.

Knot and leave a long tail. Follow the directions above with the 1st pumpkin to finish it.

### How to Crochet a Pumpkin Stem

Magic circle

6 *Sc* in magic circle. *Sl*, chain 1

6 *Sc* 1 in each stitch around, *sl* chain 1

6 *Sc* 1 in each stitch around, *sl*

Knot and leave a long tail to sew stem to top of pumpkin. Weave in ends. You can stuff the stem with Poly-fil if you want.
