

Iris Basic Beginner Scarf Crochet Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• H – 5 mm crochet hook• 1 – 7 oz (200g) of Premier Spun Colors Yarn in Iris or any worsted weight gauge 4 yarn 419 yd (384 m)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• ch– chain• sc - single crochet stitch• hdc – half double crochet stitch• dc - double crochet stitch• st/s– stitch/es

Size: approx: 8 in x 62 in (20 cm x 157 cm)

This easy crochet scarf pattern is sized for an adult women. You can make a longer or shorter scarf using a any number for the chain. Turning chain counts as first stitch of the row.

Wondering how long to make a scarf? The rule of thumb is to make it as long as they are tall, but it really depends on your preference.

The pattern is a row of single crochet, followed by a row of half double crochet and then a row of double crochet which you repeat until you get to the end of the scarf.

Chain 31

Row 1: sc in the 2nd chain from the hook and in each chain across. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 2: hdc in the 2nd st and in each stitch across. Chain 3 and turn.

Row 3: dc in the 2nd st and in each stitch across. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 4: sc in the 2nd st and in each stitch across. Chain 2 and turn.

Repeat Row 2-4 until you have the 153 rows, 62 inches, or the length you want. Ending with 3rows: 1 row of single crochet, 1 row of half double crochet, and 1 row of double crochet.

Tie and cut ends. Weave in all yarn ends. Enjoy your easy beginner crochet scarf.
