

## Moss Stitch Square Crochet Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• F/5 -3.75 - crochet hook</li><li>• 2 oz -Peaches &amp; Creme Cotton Yarn Quiet Dahlia or Evening Sea or any worsted weight gauge 4 cotton yarn</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>yo – yarn over</i></li><li>• <i>ch– chain stitch</i></li><li>• <i>sc – single crochet</i></li><li>• <i>sk– skip stitch</i></li></ul>

Each square is approx. 9 in

For a blanket approximately 36 inches by 45 in. You will need 20 block or skeins of cotton yarn.

Round 1: ch 2, in the 2nd st from you hook work \* sc, ch 1, sc, ch 2\* repeat \* to \* 3 more times being sure to work all of the st into that same st, sl st into 1st st of the round

Round 2: sl st in next sc, sl st into the ch 2 space, ch 1, \* (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner (ch 2 space), ch 1, sc in ch 1 space, ch 1 \* repeat \* to \* around, sl st into 1st st of the round (repeat to 1<sup>st</sup> corner)

Round 3: sl st into the corner, ch 1, \* (sc, ch 2, sc in corner) ch 1, sc + ch 1 in each ch 1 space across until you reach next corner\* repeat \* to \* around until you reach the very last corner, sl st into the 1st st

Continue repeating round 3 until you reach desired length. I did 21 rounds. Cut and knot your yarn when you complete your last full round.
