

Little Dot Cotton Crochet Washcloth Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• F/5 -3.75 mm crochet hook• 1 - 2 oz Peaches & Creme Cotton Yarn in Spring Blue Stripes or any other medium worsted weight gauge 4 yarn.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>ch/chs – chain/chains</i>• <i>st/sts - stitch/stitches</i>• <i>sk - skip</i>• <i>psc- picot single crochet</i>• <i>sc - single crochet</i>

Picot Single Crochet (Psc): (Worked from the WS of the fabric) Insert the hook in the next st, yo and pull up a loop. [Yo and pull through 1 loop] 3 times (as for a ch 3). Yo and pull through both loops on the hook. Push ch 3 to the back (RS) of the fabric when working the next st.

To make a larger or smaller project, use a multiple of 4+2. For a the dots to be lined-up use an even number.

Approx. size: 7.5 in x 7.5 in

ch 30

Row 1: Sc in the 2nd ch from the hook and each ch to the end. Turn and ch 1.

Row 2: sc in the 1st st. *Psc in the next st, sc in the next st. Repeat from * to end. Turn and ch 1.

Row 3: sc in each st to end. Turn and ch 1.

Row 4: sc in the first 2 sts. *Psc in the next st, sc in the next st. Repeat from * until 1 st remains. Sc in the last st. Turn and ch 1.

Row 5: sc in each st to end. Turn and ch 1.

Repeat Rows 2-5 until you have 33 rows or the desired length.

Knot end and cut yarn. Weave in yarn ends.
