

## Rainbow Dot Pot Holder Crochet Pattern

<b>Supplies</b>	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• F, 3.75 mm crochet hook</li><li>• 2 oz - Peaches and Crème in Psychedelic or any worsted weight medium gauge cotton yarn</li><li>• 2 oz - Lion Brand Re-Up Navy or any worsted weight medium gauge cotton yarn</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>yo- yarn over.</i></li><li>• <i>ch/chs – chain/chains</i></li><li>• <i>st/sts - stitch/stitches</i></li><li>• <i>sc – single crochet</i></li><li>• <i>bl – back loop</i></li><li>• <i>Bobble – bobble stitch</i></li></ul>

Special Stitch: Bobble: YO, insert hook into indicated st. YO, pull up loop. (YO, insert hook into same st. YO, pull up a loop) twice. YO, pull through all 7 loops on hook.

You can make a larger or smaller potholder or a blanket by using 3 +2 chain. Chain 1 at the beginning of rows does NOT count as stitch.

Approx. size: 9 in x 9 in (23 cm)

Chain 30 – Make two squares

Row 1: Ch 1 (does not count as a st, here and throughout) sc in first 2 sts. \*Bobble in next st, sc in next 2 sts. Rep from \* across row.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in the BL of each sc across.

Row 3: Repeat row 1.

Rep rows 2-3 for stitch pattern! 25 rows

### **Border in Navy**

Line up the 2 squares wrong sides together.

Pull up a stitch in on corner. sc in each stitch around. Put 3 sc in each corner. On the sides make one sc for each row. Make 3 rounds of sc. Slip stitch to first stitch of round. Knot and cut yarn.

Knot and weave in ends using a tapestry needle. Cut off excess yarn. Enjoy this double thick cotton pot holder.
