

## Stripe Tweed Crochet Scarf Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• 1- H 5 mm crochet hook</li><li>• 2 - 5.3 oz Lion Brand Mandala Tweed Stripes Yarn in Knock on Wood, or any gauge 4 yarn 426 yd (I used 1 1/2 skeins)</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>ch/chs</i> – <i>chain/chains</i></li><li>• <i>st/sts</i> – <i>stitch/stitches</i></li><li>• <i>sc</i> – <i>single crochet</i></li><li>• <i>dc</i> – <i>double crochet stitch</i></li></ul>

You can make a larger or smaller a blanket by using an even number for the chain. I started the pattern with 1 row of single crochet.

You place the single & double crochet in the single crochet from the row before for the entire pattern.

Size: Adult women approx.: 8 in x 80 in (20 cm x 203 cm)

ch 230

Row 1: in the 2nd *st* from the hook, *sc* and in each *st* across. ***Ch*** 1 and turn.

Row 2: ***dc*** in 1st *st*. \*skip *st* (*sc*, ***dc***) in *st*.\* repeat from \*\* to the end of the row. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 3: *dc* in the 1st stitch \* (*sc*, *dc*) in *sc* of the row below, repeat from \* to the end of the row. Chain 1 and turn.

Final row of the suzette stitch, do two single crochets in the last stitch.

Repeat Row 3 until you have 23 rows or the length you want.

Knot and weave in ends using a tapestry needle. Cut off excess yarn.

Enjoy your stripe tweed scarf crochet pattern.
