

Blue Striped Puff Scarf Crochet Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• 1- 3.75 mm crochet hook• 1 - 5.3 oz Lion Brand Mandala Yarn in Spirit, or any gauge 3 yarn 590 yds	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• ch/chs – chain/chains• st/sts – stitch/stitches• sc – single crochet• dc – double crochet stitch• berry - berry stitch

Special stitch: berry stitch – **yo** insert your hook into the space, **yo**, pull through, **yo**, and pull through 1 loop on the hook. Then, **yo**, insert your hook into the same designated space again, **yo**, pull through, **yo**, and pull through all 5 loops on the hook. chain 1.

You can make a larger or smaller a blanket by using an even number for the chain. I started the pattern with 1 row of single crochet.

Size: Adult women approx.: 10.5 in x 73 in (27 cm x 185 cm)

ch 320

Row 1: in the 2nd **st** from the hook, **sc** and in each **st** across. **Ch** 1 and turn.

Row 2: In the 1st, **hdc, dc**, skip 2 chains and in the next work **sc, hdc, dc**. Skip 2 chains and repeat “**sc, hdc, dc**” into the next space. Repeat across to the end and there is one chain left. Work 1 **sc**. Chain 1, turn.

Row 3: **hdc** and DC into the top of the **sc** you just made. Skip over the **dc** and **hdc**, ***“sc, hdc, dc”** into the **sc***. Repeat the pattern across ending the last stitch with one single crochet. Chain 1, turn.

Row 4-10: Repeat row 3.

Row 11: **sc** in each stich across. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 12: *berry stitch in 2nd st, 1 **sc***. Repeat **until end of the row. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 13: **sc** in each stitch across. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 14: In the 1st, **hdc, dc**, skip 2 chains and in the next work **sc, hdc, dc**. Skip 2 chains and repeat “**sc, hdc, dc**” into the next space. Repeat across to the end and there is one chain left. Work 1 **sc**. Chain 1, turn.

Rows 15-22: **hdc** and DC into the top of the **sc** you just made. Skip over the **dc** and **hdc**, ***“sc, hdc, dc”** into the **sc***. Repeat the pattern across ending the last stitch with one single crochet. Chain 1, turn.

Row 23: **sc** in each stich across. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 24: *berry stitch in 2nd st, 1 **sc***. Repeat **until end of the row. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 25: **sc** in each stitch across. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 26: In the 1st, **hdc, dc**, skip 2 chains and in the next work **sc, hdc, dc**. Skip 2 chains and repeat **“sc, hdc, dc”** into the next space. Repeat across to the end and there is one chain left. Work 1 **sc**. Chain 1, turn.

Rows 27-34: **hdc** and DC into the top of the **sc** you just made. Skip over the **dc** and **hdc**, ***“sc, hdc, dc”** into the **sc***. Repeat the pattern across ending the last stitch with one single crochet. Chain 1, turn.

Row 35: Final row do a row of single crochet.

You will have 35 rows or the length you want. To increase the width of the scarf repeat 1 row of single crochet then 1 row of berry followed by another row of single crochet. Then do nine rows of the sedge stitch.

Knot and weave in ends using a tapestry needle. Cut off excess yarn.
