

Woven Double Thick Cotton Crochet Pot Holder Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• scissors• tapestry needle• 1 - 2.1 oz - Lion Brand Re-Up Cotton Yarn in both gray & navy or any other worsted weight cotton yarn (60 g 98 yd)• F/5 3.75 mm crochet hook	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>ch/chs</i> – chain/chains• <i>st/sts</i> - stitch/stitches• <i>hdc</i> – half double crochet stitch• <i>dc</i> – double crochet stitch• <i>bpdc</i> - back post double crochet stitch• <i>fpdc</i> - front post double crochet stitch

Use an odd multiple of 3 +4 for the beginning chain.

Size: 8 in x 8 in (20 cm)

ch 34

Row 1: dc in the 4th ch from the hook and in each ch across. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 2: In the 2nd st, 3 bpdc in the next 3 sts, 3 fpdc in the next 3 sts, Repeat **. Last st is a hdc. Chain 2 and turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you 23 rows or the length you want. The last row is a row of double crochet.

Color changes every 2 rows.

Make another one for the back of the potholder. Whip or slip stitch the two wrong sides together.

Cut yarn and knot. Weave end all ends.
