

Candy Lane Chunky Pocket Scarf Crochet Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• 10 mm crochet hook• 3 – 5 oz. Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn, Carousel gauge 6 yarn or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn• 1 – 6 oz. Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn, Fisherman gauge 6 yarn or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>ch/chs</i> – chain/chains• <i>st/sts</i> – stitch/stitches• <i>sk</i> – skip• <i>dc</i> – double crochet stitch• <i>hdc</i> – half double crochet stitch

To make the scarf wider use a multiple of 4 + 1

Size: Adult women 7.5 in x 74 in (19 cm x 188 cm)

Ch 18

Row 1: In the 3rd ch from hook, hdc and in each chain across. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in same st the ch 2 comes out of. *ch 2, skip next 2 st, dc in those next 2 sts. Ch 2, skip next 2 sts.* Repeat ** across. Hdc in the last st. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 3: dc into the next 2 sts in the row below. *Ch 2, skip next 2 sts, dc into the next 2 sts from the row below* Repeat ** across. Hdc in the top of the ch 3 from the previous row. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 4: hdc in same st the ch 2 comes out of. Crocheting into the open sts from 2 rows below (the stitches will cover the 2 chs from the previous row), dc in those next 2 sts. *Ch 2, skip next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts from 2 rows below* Repeat ** across. Hdc in last st. Chain 2 and turn.

To finish and close in the gaps you need to:

Ch 1, sc in the same st the ch 1 comes out of, sc in the next 2 sts, *hdc in the next 2 unworked sts from 2 rows below, sc in next 2 sts* Repeat from * to * across. Sc in last st. Finish off. Weave in ends.

Color Changes: 4 rows of white, 10 rows of Carousel, 3 rows of white, 10 rows of Carousel, 3 row of white, 54 rows of Carousel, 3 rows of white, 10 rows of Carousel, 3 row of white, 10 rows of Carousel, 4 rows of white.

Scarf Pockets

Ch 12

Row 1: Hdc in the 3rd st from the hook and in each ch across. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 2: hdc in the 1st st and in each st across. Chain 2 and turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have 9 rows total. Make 2 of the pockets.

Center the pocket in the first colored section. Then sew the pocket to the center of the scarf using yarn on sides and bottom. Cut and knot yarn.

Repeat for the 2nd side. Weave in all ends. Enjoy you chunky pocket scarf!
