

Stonewash Striped Chunky Baby Blanket Crochet Pattern

| Supplies | Abbreviations – US Terms |
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| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• N, 9 mm crochet hook• 2- 10.5 oz Bernat Blanket Yarn in Stonewash or any super bulky yarn gauge 6 yarn | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>sc</i> – single crochet• <i>dc</i> - double crochet• <i>ch</i>– chain• <i>YO</i> – yarn over• <i>hbdc</i>- herringbone double crochet |

Special stitch -herringbone stitch double crochet – yarn over, insert your hook into the stitch. **yo** and pull back through the stitch and the next loop on the hook. **yo** pull through 1 loop on the hook, **yo**, pull through remaining two loops on the hook. This blanket is done lengthwise. Size: 34 in x 36 in (86 cm x 91 cm)

ch 63 odd number for chain

Row 1: hbdc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 2: hbdc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across. Chain 3 and turn.

Row 3: (dc, ch 1, dc) in the 3rd st. *sk 1, 1 dc, sk 1, (dc, ch 1, dc)* Repeat **. Last st dc. Chain 3 and turn.

Row 4: (dc, ch 1, dc) in the ch-sp of the V *sk 1, 1 dc, sk 1, (dc, ch 1, dc) in the ch sp of the V* Repeat **. Last st dc. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 5: hbdc in ch-sp and dc across. On the chain 3 from the row before do 2 hbdc. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 6: hbdc in ch-sp and dc across. On the chain 3 from the row before do 2 hbdc. Chain 3 and turn.

Repeat Rows 3-6 ending with 2 rows of hbdc.

Cut end and knot. Weave in all ends.
