

Stripe Tweed Ear Warmer Crochet Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• 1- H 5 mm crochet hook• 1 - 5.3 oz Lion Brand Mandala Tweed Stripes Yarn in Knock on Wood, or any gauge 4 yarn 426 yd (I used the rest of the skein from a scarf project)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>ch/chs</i> – <i>chain/chains</i>• <i>st/sts</i> – <i>stitch/stitches</i>• <i>sc</i> – <i>single crochet</i>• <i>dc</i> – <i>double crochet stitch</i>

You can make a larger or smaller item by using an even number for the chain. I started the pattern with 1 row of single crochet.

You place the single & double crochet in the single crochet from the row before for the entire pattern.

Size: Adult women approx.: 8 in x 80 in (20 cm x 203 cm)

ch 72

Row 1: in the 2nd *st* from the hook, *sc* and in each *st* across. **Ch** 1 and turn.

Row 2: *dc* in 1st *st*. *skip *st* (*sc*, *dc*) in *st*.* repeat from ** to the end of the row. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 3: *dc* in the 1st stitch * (*sc*, *dc*) in *sc* of the row below, repeat from * to the end of the row. Chain 1 and turn.

Final row of the suzette stitch, do two single crochets in the last stitch.

Repeat Row 3 until you have 10 rows or the length you want. I add 1 row of single crochet for a total of 11 rows.

Knot and cut yarn leaving a long tail to sew the two short ends together.

Fold the rectangle in half and slip or whip stitch the ends together. Weave in all ends.

Enjoy your stripe tweed crocheted ear warmer.
