

Woven Lines Chunky Crochet Throw Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• scissors• tapestry needle• 9 mm crochet hook• 10 - 6.4 oz (180g) Caron Colorama O'Go Yarn in Baja or any other bulky gauge 5 yarn 228 yd (208 m)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• ch/chs – chain/chains• st/sts – stitch/stitches• hdc – half double crochet stitch• dc – double crochet stitch• bpdc – back post double crochet stitch• fpdc – front post double crochet stitch

To make the blanket larger or smaller use an odd multiple of 5 + 4 for the chain. The chain 2 counts as the first stitch of each row.

Size of blanket: 43 in x 45 in (109 cm x 114 cm)

ch 109

Row 1: dc in the 4th ch from the hook and in each ch across. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 2: In the 2nd st, 5 bpdc in the next 5 sts, 5 fpdc in the next 5 sts, Repeat **. Last st is a hdc. Chain 2 and turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you 86 rows or the length you want.

Cut yarn and knot. Weave end all ends.
