

## Learn How to Crochet a Hot Pad - Easy Pattern

<b>Supplies</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• 4 mm crochet hook</li><li>• 2– 2 oz Peaches &amp; Crème Stripey Cotton Yarn in Linen or any other medium worsted weight gauge 4 yarn</li></ul>	<b>Abbreviations – US Terms</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>ch/chs</b> - chain stitch/stitches</li><li>• <b>st/sts</b> - stitch/stitches</li><li>• <b>sc</b> – single crochet</li><li>• <b>scbl</b> - single crochet back loop only</li><li>• <b>th sc</b> – thermal single crochet stitch</li></ul>
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**Special Stitch** –th sc = Thermal single crochet - Insert hook into the back loop and into the front unworked loop of the stitch from the row below. Yarn over and pull up a loop (You should have 2 loops on hook). Yarn over pull through both loops on hook.

You can make a larger or smaller potholder or a blanket by using any number for the chain.

Approx. 8 in x 8.5 in (20 cm x 22 cm)

Chain 36

Row 1: In the 2nd **st** from the hook, **sc** and in each **st** across. **Ch** 1 and turn.

Row 2: In the 2nd **st**, **scbl** and in each **st** across. **Ch** 1 and turn.

Row 3: In the 2nd **st**, **th sc** and in each **st** across. **Ch** 1 and turn.

Repeat Row 3 until you have rows 50 or the length you want.

Fold the hot pad in half and seam the sides and top. Knot and weave in ends using a tapestry needle. Cut off excess yarn.
