## How to Crochet a Rug Pattern - Stripes

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul> <li>cissors</li> <li>tapestry needle</li> <li><u>K</u>, <u>6.5 mm crochet hook</u></li> <li>1 – 10.5 ball Premier Serenity Chunky Yarn in <u>Cloud Dance</u> or any bulky gauge 5 yarn (328 yd)</li> <li>1 – 10.5 ball Premier Serenity Chunky Yarn in <u>Raven</u> or any bulky gauge 5 yarn (328 yd)</li> <li>anti slip rug grips</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>sc – single crochet</li> <li>ebc – even berry crochet</li> <li>ch – chain</li> <li>YO – yarn over</li> </ul>

**special stitch** -even berry crochet -yo insert your hook into the space, yo, pull through, yo, and pull through 1 loop on the hook. Then, yo, insert your hook into the same designated space again, yo, pull through, yo, and pull through all 5 loops on the hook.

For the even berry stitch, you need a single crochet stitch between each of the even berry stitches. You also need to alternate with a row between each of the even berry rows otherwise the texture will not be on the same side.

You can make a larger or smaller crochet item by using an odd number for the chain.

Approx. crochet rug size: 24 in x 40 in. (61 cm x 102 cm)

## Color A – White

Chain 89

Row 1: *sc* in the 2nd chain and each *ch* until the end of the row. Chain 1 turn.

Row 2: sc in 1st stich, \*ebc in next stitch, sc in next stitch,\* End with sc. Chain 1 turn.

Row 3: sc in each stitch until the end of the row. Chain 1 turn.

Repeat **Row 2-3.** 56 rows in total. Color changes as follows 3 rows of white, 6 rows of black, 3 rows of white, 9 rows of black, 14 rows of white, 9 rows of black, 3 rows of white, 6 rows of black, 3 rows of white

Tie and cut off. Weave in ends using a tapestry needle. Attach no slip grips to your rug at the corners.
