Blanket Stitch How to Square Crochet Pattern

Supplies

- scissors
- tapestry needle
- 4 mm crochet hook
- 2 2 oz Peaches & Crème Stripey Cotton Yarn in Linen or any other medium worsted weight gauge 4 yarn.

Abbreviations – US Terms

- *ch/chs* chain/chains
- *st/sts* stitch/stitches
- *sk* skip
- sc single crochet stitch
- dc double crochet stitch

Use a multiple of 3 +2 for the chain. I used 1 1/2 skeins for the 11 in square.

Size: 11 in x 11 in (28 cm)

ch 43

Row 1: In the 2nd *ch*, *sc*, and in each *st* across. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 2: In the *st* make 2 *dc*, * *sk* 2 *chs*, in next *ch* do 1 *sc* & 2 *dc*, repeat from * across until you are left with 3 *chs*, *sk* 2 *chs*, *sc* in last *ch*. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 3: In the 2nd next *st* make 2 *dc*, **sk* 2 *sts*, in the next *st* make 1 *sc* & 2 *dc*, repeat from * across until you are left with 3 *sts*, *sk* 2 *sts*, *sc* into the top of the turning *ch*. Chain 1 and turn.

Repeat Row 3 until you have 32 rows or the length you want. The last row is single crochet.

Cut yarn and knot. Weave end all ends.

For a blanket approximately 44 in x 55 in. you will need 20 squares. You would need round 27 skeins of the Peaches and Crème yarn.
