

## Blanket Stitch How to Square Crochet Pattern

<b>Supplies</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• 4 mm crochet hook</li><li>• 2 – 2 oz Peaches &amp; Crème Stripey Cotton Yarn in Linen or any other medium worsted weight gauge 4 yarn.</li></ul>	<b>Abbreviations – US Terms</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>ch/chs</b> – chain/chains</li><li>• <b>st/sts</b> - stitch/stitches</li><li>• <b>sk</b>- skip</li><li>• <b>sc</b> – single crochet stitch</li><li>• <b>dc</b> – double crochet stitch</li></ul>
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Use a multiple of 3 +2 for the chain. I used 1 1/2 skeins for the 11 in square.

Size: 11 in x 11 in (28 cm)

ch 43

**Row 1:** In the 2nd **ch**, **sc**, and in each **st** across. Chain 1 and turn.

**Row 2:** In the **st** make 2 **dc**, \* **sk** 2 **chs**, in next **ch** do 1 **sc** & 2 **dc**, repeat from \* across until you are left with 3 **chs**, **sk** 2 **chs**, **sc** in last **ch**. Chain 1 and turn.

**Row 3:** In the 2nd next **st** make 2 **dc**, \***sk** 2 **sts**, in the next **st** make 1 **sc** & 2 **dc**, repeat from \* across until you are left with 3 **sts**, **sk** 2 **sts**, **sc** into the top of the turning **ch**. Chain 1 and turn.

Repeat Row 3 until you have 32 rows or the length you want. The last row is single crochet.

Cut yarn and knot. Weave end all ends.

For a blanket approximately 44 in x 55 in. you will need 20 squares. You would need round 27 skeins of the Peaches and Crème yarn.
