Houndstooth Stitch Washcloth Crochet Pattern

Supplies

- Scissors
- tapestry needle
- 4 mm crochet hook
- 2 -3.5 oz <u>Lion Brand 24/7 Cotton Yarn</u> in terracotta and gray or any worsted weight gauge 4 cotton yarn

Abbreviations – US Terms

- *yo* yarn over
- *ch* chain
- *dc* double crochet
- sc single crochet
- st/sts stitch/stitches

You can make a larger or smaller crochet dish cloth or a blanket by using a multiple of 2 + 1 for the chain.

As you are working your rows, carry the non working yarn – in this case color A – along with you behind your work. You may choose to carefully work over top of the yarn to hide it.

You will change colors at the last stitch of each row right before you complete the stitch.

Approx. size: 11 in x 11 in (28 cm)

Ch 37 in Gray (Color A)

Row 1: Sc in the 2nd ch from your hook, *dc in the next ch, sc in the next ch; Repeat from * across ending with a dc in the final ch. Change to color B in the final st. Ch 1, turn.

Row 2: sc in the 1st st, *dc in the next st, sc in the next st; Repeat from * across ending with a dc in the final sc. Change to color A in the final st. Ch 1, turn.

Row 3: sc in the 1st st, *dc in the next st, sc in the next st; Repeat from * across ending with a dc in the final sc. Change to color B in the final st. Ch 1, turn.

Repeat Row 2-3 until you have 33 rows or the length you want. End with the same color you started with.

Border

Turn and sc in each stitch around and down both sides. 3 sc in each corner and approximately 1 sc for each row on the sides. Do two rounds and slip stitch to the first stitch.

Knot yarn and cut off. Weave in ends using a tapestry needle.
