

Lilac Fade Crochet Baby Blanket Pattern

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• N, 9 mm crochet hook• 3– 10.5 cakes of Bernat Baby Blanket Yarn Dappled– Misty Jungle Green or any super bulky	<p>Abbreviations – US Terms</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• ch – chain• dc – double crochet• dc2tog - double crochet 2 together
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Abbreviations – US Term

- **ch** – chain
- **dc** – double crochet
- dc2tog - double crochet 2 together

special stitch, double crochet together: **YO**, insert hook into first stitch from row below, **yo** and pull through drawing up three loops on hook, **yo**, pull through two loops, **yo**, insert hook into same stitch from row below, **yo** and pull through to draw up three loops on hook, **yo** and draw through 2 loops, **yo** and draw through last 3 loops.

Cluster V-Stitch: Dc2tog, ch 2, dc2tog all in the same space

To make this blanket bigger or smaller chain a multiple of 3+1. The turning chain counts as the first stitch.

Approx. size of blanket: 38 in x 44 in (97 cm x 112 cm)

Gauge: 2 stitches by 3 rows = 4 in (10.16 cm) of cluster V stitch

Ch 85

Row 1: (dc2tog, ch 2, dc2tog) in 5th ch from hook. *Skip 2 chs, (dc2tog, ch 2, dc2tog) in next. Repeat from * across until 2 chs remain. Skip 1 ch. Dc in last. Turn

Row 2: Ch 3, (dc2tog, ch 2, dc2tog) in each ch 2 space across. Dc in last stitch. Turn

Repeat row 2 until you have 37 rows.

Knot, cut end and weave ends with a tapestry needle.
