

Summer Breeze Baby Blanket Crochet Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 2- 8.8 oz (250 g) Caron Cotton Funnel cakes in Breeze or any other medium worsted weight gauge 4 yarn• 2- 8.8 oz (250 g) Caron Cotton Funnel cakes in Cerulean or any other medium worsted weight gauge 4 yarn• 1- 8.8 oz (250 g) Caron Cotton Funnel cakes in Cumulus or any other medium worsted weight gauge 4 yarn• H - 5mm crochet hook• scissors• tapestry needle	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>ch</i>– chain• <i>dc</i>– double crochet stitch• <i>sc</i> – single crochet stitch• <i>bpsc</i> – back post single crochet stitch• <i>fpsc</i> – front post single crochet stitch• <i>st</i>– stitch

You can make a smaller or larger project using an even number for the chain.

Approx. size: 46 in x 54 in (117 cm x 137 cm)

ch 150

Row 1: ***Dc*** in 4th ***ch*** from hook and each ***ch*** across, turn.

Row 2: ***ch*** 1, ***sc*** in 1st ***dc***, ****bpsc*** in next ***sc***, ***fpsc*** in next ***sc***; rep from *. Repeat ** across. ***sc*** in top of turning chain, turn.

Row 3: ***ch*** 3, ***dc*** in each ***sc*** across, turn.

Row 4: ***ch*** 1, ***sc*** in 1st ***dc***, ****fpsc*** in next ***sc***, ***bpsc*** in next ***sc**** Repeat from ** across. ***sc*** in top of turning chain, turn. Change to blue multi.

Row 5: ***ch*** 2. Skip one ***ch***, then ***sc***, ***ch*** 1. Skip the next ***ch*** and continue the pattern of ***sc***, CH 1, ***sk*** 1 all the way across. Your last stitch in the final chain should be a ***sc***. Turn.

Row 6: ***ch*** 1. ***sc*** into the ***sc*** you just made on the row below. ***ch*** 1, skip the chain space, ***sc*** into the ***sc***. Repeat the sequence all the way across. Ending again with a ***sc*** in the last ***sc***.

Rows 7-32: Repeat Row 6.

Row 33: ch 3, dc in each st across. Turn

Row 34: ***ch*** 1, ***sc*** in 1st ***dc***, ****bpsc*** in next ***sc***, ***fpsc*** in next ***sc***; rep from *. Repeat ** across. ***sc*** in top of turning chain, turn.

Row 35: **ch 3, dc** in each **sc** across, turn.

Row 36: **ch 1, sc** in 1st **dc**, ***fp**sc in next **sc**, **bp**sc in next **sc*** Repeat from ** across. **sc** in top of turning chain, turn.

Row 37: **ch 3, dc** in each **sc** across, turn.

Rows 38-56: Repeat Rows 34-37. Change to cream.

Row 57: **ch 2**. Skip one **ch**, then **sc, ch 1**. Skip the next **ch** and continue the pattern of **sc, CH 1, sk 1** all the way across. Your last stitch in the final chain should be a **sc**. Turn.

Row 58: **ch 1, sc** into the **sc** you just made on the row below. **ch 1**, skip the chain space, **sc** into the **sc**. Repeat the sequence all the way across. Ending again with a **sc** in the last **sc**.

Rows 59-77: Repeat Row 58. Change to blue

Row 78: **ch 3, dc** in each **st** across. turn

Row 79: **ch 1, sc** in 1st **dc**, ***bp**sc in next **sc**, **fp**sc in next **sc**; rep from *. Repeat ** across. **sc** in top of turning chain, turn.

Row 80: **ch 3, dc** in each **sc** across, turn.

Row 81: **ch 1, sc** in 1st **dc**, ***fp**sc in next **sc**, **bp**sc in next **sc*** Repeat from ** across. **sc** in top of turning chain, turn.

Row 82: **ch 3, dc** in each **sc** across, turn.

Rows 83-100: Repeat Rows 79-82. Change to blue multi.

Row 101: **ch 2**. Skip one **ch**, then **sc, ch 1**. Skip the next **ch** and continue the pattern of **sc, CH 1, sk 1** all the way across. Your last stitch in the final chain should be a **sc**. Turn.

Row 102: **ch 1, sc** into the **sc** you just made on the row below. **ch 1**, skip the chain space, **sc** into the **sc**. Repeat the sequence all the way across. Ending again with a **sc** in the last **sc**.

Rows 103-129: Repeat Row 102. Change to cream.

Row 130: **ch 3, dc** in **st** across. Turn.

Row 131: **ch 1, sc** in 1st **dc**, ***bp**sc in next **sc**, **fp**sc in next **sc**; rep from *. Repeat ** across. **sc** in top of turning chain, turn.

Row 132: **ch 3, dc** in each **sc** across, turn.

Row 133: *ch* 1, *sc* in 1st *dc*, **fp**sc* in next *sc*, *bp**sc* in next *sc** Repeat from ** across. *sc* in top of turning chain, turn.

Cut the yarn and knot. Weave in all ends. Enjoy your Summer Breeze Cotton Crochet Baby Blanket.

Color changes: 4 rows of cream, 28 rows in multicolor, 22 rows in blue, 20 rows in cream, 22 rows in blue, 28 rows in multicolor, 4 rows in cream.
