

Houndstooth Cotton Baby Blanket Crochet Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• scissors• tapestry needle• 4 mm crochet hook• 3- 4.2 oz (120 g) Bernat Softee Baby Cotton Yarn in Aqua Mist or any gauge 3 yarn 254 yd (232 m)• 3- 4.2 oz (120 g) Bernat Softee Baby Cotton Yarn in Feather Gray or any gauge 3 yarn 254 yd (232 m)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>yo</i> – yarn over• <i>ch</i> – chain• <i>dc</i> - double crochet• <i>sc</i> – single crochet• <i>st/sts</i> - stitch/stitches

You can make a larger or smaller crochet item by using a multiple of 2 + 1 for the chain.

As you are working your rows, carry the non working yarn – in this case color A – along with you behind your work. You may choose to carefully work over top of the yarn to hide it.

You will change colors at the last stitch of each row right before you complete the stitch.

Approx. blanket. size: 36 in x 36 in (91 cm)

Ch 131 in Gray (Color A)

Row 1: *Sc* in the 2nd *ch* from your hook, **dc* in the next *ch*, *sc* in the next *ch*; Repeat from * across ending with a *dc* in the final *ch*. Change to color B in the final *st*. *Ch* 1, turn.

Row 2: *sc* in the 1st *st*, **dc* in the next *st*, *sc* in the next *st*; Repeat from * across ending with a *dc* in the final *sc*. Change to color A in the final *st*. *Ch* 1, turn.

Row 3: *sc* in the 1st *st*, **dc* in the next *st*, *sc* in the next *st*; Repeat from * across ending with a *dc* in the final *sc*. Change to color B in the final *st*. *Ch* 1, turn.

Repeat Row 2-3 until you have 120 rows or the length you want. End with the same color you started with.

Knot yarn and cut off. Weave in ends using a tapestry needle.
