

# Charlie Chunky Chenille Baby Blanket Crochet Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• <a href="#">10 mm crochet hook</a></li><li>• 2- 10.5 oz (300g) Stitch Studio by Nicole Chateau in Deep Blue Mix or any super chunky gauge 6 yarn 258 yds (234 m)</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>sc</i> – single crochet</li><li>• <i>dc</i> - double crochet</li><li>• <i>bobble</i> – bobble stitch 4 double crochet together</li><li>• <i>ch</i>– chain</li><li>• <i>YO</i> – yarn over</li></ul>

**Special stitch:** Bobble stitch -dc4tog – Yarn over (**yo**) and pull up a loop, now pull through two. (2 loops left on hook) **yo** into the same space as before, pull up a loop, pull through two, (3 loops left on the hook), **yo** and do it again, (4 loops left) **yo**, do the same again, (5 loops, you got it) Now **yo** and pull through all those 5 loops. Stitch is complete.

The starting chain 1 and chain 3 count as the first stitch of each row.

The crochet pattern is a multiple of 5 plus 2 for the starting chain. I did the chain lengthwise.

Baby blanket size: approx. 32 in x 40 in (81 cm x 102 cm)

ch 62

Row 1: dc in the 4th st from the hook and each st across. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 2: sc in the 2nd st and the next 8.\* 1 bobble, 1 sc, 1 bobble, 1 sc, 1 bobble, 10 sc\* Repeat \*\* Chain 3 and turn.

Row 3: dc in the 2nd st and in each st across. Chain 1 and turn.

Repeat Rows 2-3 until you have 31 rows or the length you want. End with a row of double crochet.
