

Free Bradley Moss Stitch Baby Blanket Crochet Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• K - 6.5 mm Crochet Hook• 2 – 8 oz (227 g) O'Go Caron Colorama Yarn in Skylight Frost or any gauge 5 bulky yarn 481 yd (440 m)• 2 – 8 oz (227 g) O'Go Caron Colorama Yarn in Graphite Frost or any gauge 5 bulky yarn 481 yd (440 m)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>yo</i> – yarn over• <i>ch</i>– chain stitch• <i>sc</i> – single crochet• <i>sk</i>– skip stitch

To increase or decrease the size of the moss stitch blanket, use an even number.

For this pattern use hold two strands of yarn together. I started with the dark of the Graphite Frost and Skylight Frost Yarn and used both strands together.

I then started with the light side of the yarn for the second skeins. So, the blanket goes from dark to light to dark again.

approx. blanket size: 36 in x 50 in (91 cm x 127 cm)

Ch 110 - 2 strands of yarn together

Row 1: **sc** in the 4nd chain from the hook, 1 **ch**, **sk** the next stitch, **sc** in the next stitch. Repeat until the end of the row ending with a **sc** in the last chain. Chain 2, turn.

Row 2: **sc** in the chain space from the row below. Then ***ch** 1, **sk** 1 **sc**, **sc** in next **ch** 1 space*. Repeat from * until the end of the row. The last **sc** is worked into the space between the **ch** 2 turning chain and **sc** from the row before. Chain 2, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have rows or the length needed. Cut yarn weave ends. Enjoy your moss stitch crochet blanket.
