## Soft Spa Washcloth Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul> <li>Scissors</li> <li>Tapestry Needle</li> <li><u>1- 3.5 oz Coboo Yarn in Steel Blue or any other cotton yarn gauge 3 yarn 232 yd</u></li> <li>3.5 mm crochet hook</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>yo – yarn over</li> <li>sl – slip stitch</li> <li>sc – single crochet</li> <li>hdc – half double crochet</li> <li>dc – double crochet stitch</li> </ul>

You can make a larger or smaller <u>dishcloth</u> or a blanket by using an multiple of 3 + 2 for the chain.

The chain 1 does not count as the 1st stitch of the row.

ch 38

Row 1: In 2nd chain from the hook, sc in each st across. Chain 1 and turn

Row 2: *sc*, *hdc*, *dc* in the 1st *st* of the row, skip 2 chains and in the next work *sc*, *hdc*, *dc*. Skip 2 chains and repeat "*sc*, *hdc*, *dc*" into the next space. Repeat across to the end until there is one chain left. Work 1 *sc*. Chain 1, turn.

Row 3: *sc*, *hdc* into the top of the *sc* you just made. *dc* in the stitch 2 rows below. Skip over the *dc* and *hdc*, *\*"sc*, *hdc*" into the *sc*. *dc* in the 2 stitch 2 rows below\*. Repeat the pattern across ending the last stitch with one single crochet. Chain 1, turn.

Repeat row 3 until you have 24 rows or a square. Cut yarn and knot, weave in ends.
