

# Confetti Crochet Baby Blanket Pattern



<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 2- 10.5 oz (300 g) of Bernat Baby Blanket Yarn in Pitter Patter or any gauge #6 super bulky yarn 220 yd (201 m)</li><li>• scissors</li><li>• yarn or tapestry needle</li><li>• 10 mm crochet hook</li></ul>	<p>Abbreviations – US Terms</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>ch/chs</b> – chain/chains</li><li>• <b>st/sts</b> – stitch/stitches</li><li>• <b>sc</b> – single crochet</li><li>• <b>dc</b> – double crochet stitch</li></ul>
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## *Tips for the Blanket Pattern*

- Chain an even number for the starting chain.
- Leave long yarn tails for chenille yarn.

baby blanket size: 29.5 in x 33 in (75 cm x 84 cm)

throw size: 60 in x 70 in ch 114 do 117 rows (9 skeins)

ch 56

Row 1: In the 2nd *st* from the hook, *sc* and in each *st* across. **Ch** 1 and turn.

Row 2: (*sc*, *dc*) in 1st *st*. \*skip *st* (*sc*, *dc*) in *st*.\* repeat from \*\* to the end of the row. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 3: *dc* in the 1st stitch \* (*sc*, *dc*) in *sc* of the row below, repeat from \* to the end of the row. Chain 1 and turn.

Final row of the suzette stitch, do two single crochets in the last stitch. Then follow with one row of single crochet.

Repeat Row 3 until you have 50 rows or the length you want.

Cut and knot yarn. Weave in all ends. Leave long yarn tails so the yarn has less chance of unraveling.
