

## Even Moss Stitch Potholder Pattern



### Supplies

- 1 – 4 oz Lily Sugar n Cream in Teal or Coral Seas Ombre any other worsted weight category #4 100% cotton yarn
- scissors
- tapestry needle
- 1- H 5 mm crochet hook

### Abbreviations – US Terms

- *yo* – yarn over
- *slst* – slip stitch
- *sc* – single crochet
- *hdc* – half double crochet

You can make a larger or smaller crocheted even moss stitch project with an even number of chains.

Approx. size of potholder: 7 in x 7.5 in (18 cm x 19 cm)

Chain 36

Round 1: In 2nd chain from the hook, *sc* in each chain until the end. Add 1 extra *sc* in the last chain. Continue around *sc* in each chain on the opposite side. Add one extra *sc* at the last *sc*.

Round 2: \**slst* in the 1st st, *hdc* in the next st.\* Repeat \*\*. (slip stitch will always be on top of *slst* from the row before. Half double crochet stitch will always be on top of the *hdc*.)

Repeat round 2 until you have 20 rounds or the 2 sides meet and form a square or rectangle.

Cut yarn and knot, leaving a long tail. Sew the center seam together using the yarn you just cut. Weave in all ends.
