

Ombre Textured Throw Blanket Pattern



<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• H – 5 mm crochet hook• 4 – 10 oz skeins of Red Heart Super Saver Ombre Yarn – Anthracite or any worsted weight gauge 4 yarn. (1928 yd, 40 oz)	<p>Abbreviations – US Terms</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>yo</i> – <i>yarn over</i>• <i>sc</i> – <i>single crochet</i>• <i>ebc</i> – <i>even berry crochet stitch</i>• <i>hbdc</i> – <i>herringbone double crochet stitch</i>
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special stitch – [herringbone double crochet stitch](#) – yarn over, insert your hook into the stitch. *yo* and pull back through the stitch and the next loop on the hook. *yo* pull through 1 loop on the hook, *yo*, pull through remaining two loops on the hook.

special stitch – [even berry crochet](#) – yo insert your hook into the space, yo, pull through, yo, and pull through 1 loop on the hook.

Then, yo, insert your hook into the same designated space again, yo, pull through, yo, and pull through all 5 loops on the hook.

For the even berry stitch, you need a single crochet stitch between each of the even berry stitches. You also need to alternate with a row between each of the even berry rows.

Otherwise, the texture will not be on the same side.

Gauge: 5 in x 5 in(12.7cm): 16 hbdc stitches by 6 rows

Approx. 36 in x 59 in (91 cm x 150 cm)

Chain 104

You can make a larger or smaller blanket by using an odd number +3 for the chain.

Row 1: **hdc** in the 3rd chain from hook repeat until the end of the chain, chain 3 turn (101 st)

Row 2: **hdc** in the first **hdc** repeat until the end of the chain, chain 3 turn (101 st)

Row 3: Repeat row 2 until you have 20 rows. On row 20 chain 1 and turn.

Row 4: **sc** in the first **hdc**, **ebc**, **sc** in next stitch, ebc, repeat until the end of the row. End with a **sc** . Chain 1 turn

Row 5: **sc** in the first stitch and all away across. Chain 1 turn.

Row 6: Repeat row 4 & 5 until you have 18 rows. Chain 3 on the last row.

Row 39: Repeat Row 2 until you have 20 rows. Chain 1 and turn on last row.

Row 59: Repeat Row 4 and 5 until you have 18 rows. Chain 3 and turn on the last row.

Row 77: Repeat Row 2 until you have 20 rows.

Knot and weave in ends using a tapestry needle. Cut off excess yarn. Enjoy
