

Tea Stripe Chunky Crochet Throw Blanket Pattern

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• N – 9 mm crochet hook• 4 – 6.4 oz (180 g) Caron Colorarma O’Go Yarn in Tabby or any gauge 5 bulky yarn 228 yd	<p>Abbreviations – US Terms</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• yo – yarn over• hbdc – herringbone double crochet

special stitch -herringbone double crochet – yarn over, insert your hook into the stitch. **yo** and pull back through the stitch and the next loop on the hook. **yo** pull through 1 loop on the hook, **yo**, pull through remaining two loops on the hook. See below for written and photo tutorial of the herringbone double crochet stitch.

You can make a larger or smaller super chunky yarn blanket by using any number for the chain.

Approx. 37 in x 58 in (94 cm x 147 cm)

Chain 113

Row 1: **hbdc** in the 3rd chain from hook repeat until the end of the chain, chain 3 turn

Row 2: **hbdc** in the first **hbdc** repeat until the end of the chain, chain 3 turn

Row 3: Repeat row 2 until you have 55 rows or used all your yarn that you can ending with a full row of the same color. Tie and cut off. Weave in ends.
