

2 Tone Textured Crochet Ear Warmer Pattern

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| Supplies <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• H, 5 mm crochet hook• 1 ball of each Lion Brand Homespun Yarn 6 oz, Pearls & Desert Mountain, gauge 5 yarn (approx. 1 oz or 35 yd of each color) or any bulky gauge yarn. | Abbreviations – US Terms <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>sl</i> – <i>slip stitch</i>• <i>sc</i> – <i>single crochet</i>• <i>ch</i> – <i>chain</i>• <i>sk</i> – <i>skip</i>• <i>sp</i> – <i>space</i>• <i>blo</i> – <i>crochet in back loop only</i> |
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special stitch – single back loop only (*blo*)– do the single crochet like your normally would but only put the hook in the back loop (the loop the farthest away from you).

This pattern uses the [moss stitch](#) in the round.

Gauge: 8 single crochet x 5 rows = 3 in x 3 in

Size: Adult women approx. 19 in circumference

Measure the circumference of the head you want to fit. To make bigger or smaller increase or decrease the rows by 2s in the ribbed part of the pattern. Use the same amount of stitches in the body part.

This pattern has stretch or negative ease so you want to make it 2 in smaller than the distance around your head.

Version 1 - Texture Crochet Ear Warmer

ch 9 in color A

Row 1: *sc* in the second *ch* from the hook and *sc* across (8). Turn.

Row 2-48: *ch* 1, *sc* in the *blo* across (8). Turn.

When you finish the ribbed band, fold it half so row 1 and row 48 match up. Working through the back loop of Row 48 and the front loop of Row 1, seam the two rows together by slip stitching across.

Do not cut your yarn. Continue on to work in rounds along the edge of ribbed band.

Round 1: **ch** 1, **sc** around the top of the band working one stitch per row (48). Attach to first **sc** of the round with a **sl**.

Round 2: **ch** 1, ***SC**, **ch** 1, skip 1, repeat from * around. Attach to the first **sc** of the round with a **sl**. (48).

Round 3: **sc** 2, skip 1, **sc** in **ch** space from previous round, ***ch** 1, skip 1, **sc** in the **ch** space from the previous round, repeat from * around. Attach to the 2nd **ch** from the starting **ch** 2 with a **sl**.(48)

Change to Color B

Rounds 4-8: Continue repeating Round 2 and Round 3.

Cut yarn and tie off. Weave in ends.

2nd version

Round 1: **ch** 1, **sc** around the top of the band working one stitch per row (48). Attach to first **sc** of the round with a **sl**.

Change to Color B

Round 2: **ch** 1, ***SC**, **ch** 1, skip 1, repeat from * around. Attach to the first **sc** of the round with a **sl**. (48).

Round 3: **sc** 2, skip 1, **sc** in **ch** space from previous round, ***ch** 1, skip 1, **sc** in the **ch** space from the previous round, repeat from * around. Attach to the 2nd **ch** from the starting **ch** 2 with a **sl**.(48)

Round 4-7 repeat round 2 and 3 in color B

Change to Color A

Round 8-9 repeat round 2 and 3 in color A
