## Bright Stripe Blanket Crochet Pattern

## Supplies

- scissors
- tapestry needle
- 4 mm crochet hook
- 2 -10.5 oz (300 g) Lion Brand Mandala Bonus Bundle in Giant or any other weight #3 DK yarn 1181 yd (1080 m)

Abbreviations - US Terms

- yo yarn over
- st/sts stitch
- ch chain
- hdc-half double crochet
- fpdc-front post double crochet
- bpdc double crochet back post
- dc– double crochet

front post double crochet stitch – yarn over, insert the hook behind the post from the front, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on your hook, yo, pull thru remaining two loops on your hook. For more info <a href="here">here</a>, from yarnspirations.com.

back post double crochet stitch – yarn over, insert the hook from the back of the post, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on your hook, yo, pull thru remaining two loops on your hook. For more info <a href="here">here</a>, from yarnspirations.com.

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Row 1: Dc in 3rd ch from the hook. dc in each ch to the end. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 2: hdc in 1st st. \*fpdc around next stitch, bpdc around next st; repeat from \* until you have 2 sts remaining. Fpdc, hdc in top of turning ch. Chain 1, and turn.

Repeat row 2 until you have 128 rows or the length you want. Cut yarn and weave in ends with a tapestry needle.

Tip: I cut the skein of yarn into different colors because I didn't want so much blue or yellow together at one time. I alternated the 2 skeins for 2 rows each until I got to the sections where there was 3 yellows in a row.
