

## Bright Stripe Blanket Crochet Pattern

<b>Supplies</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• 4 mm crochet hook</li><li>• 2 -10.5 oz (300 g) Lion Brand Mandala Bonus Bundle in Giant or any other weight #3 DK yarn 1181 yd (1080 m)</li></ul>	<b>Abbreviations – US Terms</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>yo – yarn over</i></li><li>• <i>st/sts – stitch</i></li><li>• <i>ch – chain</i></li><li>• <i>hdc– half double crochet</i></li><li>• <i>fpdc– front post double crochet</i></li><li>• <i>bpdc – double crochet back post</i></li><li>• <i>dc– double crochet</i></li></ul>
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**front post double crochet stitch** – yarn over, insert the hook behind the post from the front, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on your hook, yo, pull thru remaining two loops on your hook. **back post double crochet stitch** – yarn over, insert the hook from the back of the post, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on your hook, yo, pull thru remaining two loops on your hook. For more info [here](#), from yarnspirations.com.

**Ch 221**

**Row 1:** *Dc* in 3rd *ch* from the hook. *dc* in each *ch* to the end. Chain 1 and turn.

**Row 2:** *hdc* in 1st *st*. \**fpdc* around next stitch, *bpdc* around next *st*; repeat from \* until you have 2 *sts* remaining. *Fpdc*, *hdc* in top of turning *ch*. Chain 1, and turn.

Repeat row 2 until you have 128 rows or the length you want. Cut yarn and weave in ends with a tapestry needle.

**Tip:** I cut the skein of yarn into different colors because I didn't want so much blue or yellow together at one time. I alternated the 2 skeins for 2 rows each until I got to the sections where there was 3 yellows in a row.
