

Black Puff Chunky Crochet Cowl Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 2 – 5 oz (140 g) Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick and Quick Yarn in Blackstone or any gauge 6 super bulky yarn 87 yd (80 m)• 1- 7.9 oz (225 g) Bernat Casa Yarn in Gray Shade or any gauge 6 super bulky yarn 170 yd (155 m)• 8 mm crochet hook• Scissors• Tapestry or yarn needle	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>ch</i> – chain• <i>sk</i>– skip• <i>sc</i> – single crochet• <i>puff</i> – puff stitch• <i>st/sts</i> - stitch or stitches

Tips for Pattern

- You need an even number for the chain
- size: 9 in x 19 in flat (48 cm x cm) adult woman

Ch 60

Row 1: sc in the 2nd chain from the hook and in each chain across. Chain 3 and turn.

Row 2: puff in the 2nd st, ch 1. Skip 1 st. * Puff stitch, ch1, skip 1 st.* Repeat ** until the last st. Ending with dc in the last st. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 3:* sc in the top of the puff stitch, and the next chain space*. Repeat ** until the end of the row, ending with sc in the last st. Chain 3 and turn.

Repeat rows 2-3 ending with a row of single crochet, for a total of 11 rows.

2nd Side

Pull up a loop using the Casa Yarn and single crochet in each stitch across. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 2: sc in 2nd stitch and in each st across. Chain 1 and turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have 17 rows. Then turn and slip stitch to the front section of the cowl.

Finishing

Fold the cowl in half horizontal and sew the short ends together. Weave in all ends.
