

# Tideway Chunky Baby Blanket Crochet Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 3 -10.5 oz of Bernat Baby Blanket Yarn in Lovely Blue or any gauge #6 super bulky yarn</li><li>• 10 mm crochet hook</li><li>• Scissors</li><li>• Yarn or tapestry needle</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>ch/chs</i> – chain/chains</li><li>• <i>st/sts</i> - stitch/stitches</li><li>• <i>sc</i> – single crochet stitch</li><li>• <i>dc</i> – double crochet stitch</li><li>• <i>fpsc</i> - front post single crochet stitch</li><li>• <i>bpsc</i> - back post single crochet stitch</li></ul>

Size: 36 in x 42 in (91 cm x 107 cm)

Ch 64

Row 1: sc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook and in each ch across. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 2: sc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> st and in each st across. Chain 3 and turn.

Row 3: dc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> st and in each st across. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 4: \*fpsc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> st, bpsc\* in the next. Repeat \*\*. Last st sc. Chain 3 and turn.

Row 5: dc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> st and in each st across. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 6: \*bpsc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> st, fpsc\* in the next. Repeat \*\*. Last st sc. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 7: sc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> st and in each st across. Chain 1 and turn.

Repeat Rows 2-7 until you rows or the length you want. End with 2 rows of sc.

Cut and knot yarn. Weave in all ends.
