

Beatrice Wave Baby Blanket Crochet Pattern with Border

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<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• 10 mm crochet hook• 3– 9.9 oz Bernat Forever Fleece in White Noise or any other super bulky yarn• 3– 9.9 oz Bernat Forever Fleece in White Noise or any other super bulky yarn	<p>Abbreviations – US Terms</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>ch</i> – <i>chain</i>• <i>yo</i> – <i>yarn over</i>• <i>sl st</i> - <i>slip stitch</i>• <i>sc</i> – <i>single crochet</i>• <i>hdc</i> - <i>half double crochet</i>• <i>dc</i> – <i>double crochet</i>• <i>tr</i> - <i>triple or treble crochet</i>
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To make the blanket larger or smaller you need a chain of 8+2.

Approx. size: 31 in x 40 in (79 cm x 102 cm)

Chain 66 in white

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from the hook, sc across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, [sl st, sc, hdc, dc, tr, dc, hdc, sc] until last st, sl st, turn.

Color B. pink

Row 3: Ch 1, sl st across, turn.

Color A. white

Row 4: Work in the previous row (in the 2 loops in main color yarn): Ch 3, [tr, dc, hdc, sc, sl st, sc, hdc, dc] until last st, tr, turn.

Color B. pink

Row 5: Repeat Row 3.

After 43 rows switch the color and have pink be the main color and white be the accent.

Repeat 2-5 until you have 85 rows ending 1 row of sc.

Border in Pink

Round 1-4: sc in each stitch around, 3 sc in each corner.

Round 5: * 1 sc, 3 ch, 1 sc, skip 2*. Repeat **

Cut and knot yarn. Weave in all ends.
