

## Suzette Stitch Bowl Cozy Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 3- 2 oz (56.7g ) Peaches &amp; Crème Yarn in Evening Sea or any gauge 4 worsted weight yarn 102 yd (93 m)</li><li>• scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• 1- 4 mm crochet hook</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>yo</i> – yarn over</li><li>• <i>ch</i>- chain</li><li>• <i>sc</i> – single crochet</li><li>• <i>dc</i> –double crochet</li><li>• <i>st/sts</i> - stitches</li></ul>

You can make a larger or smaller crocheted with an even number of chains.

Approx. size of potholder: 9.5 in x 9.5 in flat (24 cm)

Chain 56

Round 1: In 2nd chain from the hook, *sc* in each chain until the end. Add 1 extra *sc* in the last chain. Continue around *sc* in each chain on the opposite side. Add one extra *sc* at the last *sc*.

Round 2: (*sc*, *dc*) in 1st *st*. \*skip *st* (*sc*, *dc*) in *st*.\* repeat from \*\* to the end of the row.

Row 3: (*sc*, *dc*) in the 1<sup>st</sup> *sc* and in each *sc* skipping the double. Repeat to the end of the row.

Repeat round 3 until you have 26 rounds or the 2 sides meet and form a square.

Cut yarn and knot, leaving a long tail. Sew the center seam together using the yarn you just cut. Weave in all ends.

Take the corners of the potholder and pinch them together. Then sew the through the two sides until it is secure for 2 ¼ in. Repeat for the other 3 corners.

Weave in all ends.
