

# Triple Dot Cotton Crochet Dishcloth Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 1 -2 oz Peaches and Crème Cotton Yarn in Spring Blue Stripes or any worsted weight gauge 4 cotton yarn</li><li>• 4 mm crochet hook</li><li>• Tapestry or yarn needle</li><li>• scissors</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>ch</i>—<i>chain stitch</i></li><li>• <i>tr</i>- <i>triple or treble crochet</i></li><li>• <i>sc</i>- <i>single crochet</i></li><li>• <i>st/sts</i> – <i>stitch/es</i></li></ul>

Size: 8 in (20 cm)

Chain 1 does not count as first st after Row 1.

Ch 32

Row 1 single crochet in the 2<sup>nd</sup> st and each st across. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 2: single in 1<sup>st</sup> st, tr in 2<sup>nd</sup>. Repeat sc, tr ending with sc in last st. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 3: sc in 1<sup>st</sup> st and each st across chain 1 and turn.

Repeat Rows 2-3 until you have 29 rows ending with a row of single crochet

Cut and knot yarn. Weave in all ends.

You are doing 1 row of single crochet, then a row of single crochet, triple crochet alternating.
