

Large Colorful Granny Square Bag Crochet Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1 - 5.3 oz Lion Brand Mandala Baby Yarn in Naria or any other 3 gauge yarn 590 yd• 1- 10.5 oz Bernat Baby Blanket Yarn in White or any other 3 gauge yarn• crochet hook 3.75 mm• scissors• tapestry or yarn needle	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>ch</i> – <i>chain</i>• <i>sk</i>– <i>skip</i>• <i>dc</i> – <i>half double crochet</i>• <i>sl st</i> – <i>slip stitch</i>

Round 1: Chain 3 (counts as 1st dc). In the loop work 2dc, ch-3, 3dc, ch-3, 3dc, ch-3, 3dc, ch-3, sl st to top of starting ch 3.

Round 2: Sl st to next space. Ch 3, 2 dc, ch-3, 3 dc (1st corner made), *ch-1, (3 dc, ch-3, 3dc) in next corner*, repeat * to * 2 more times. Ch 1. Join with a sl st to the top of the 1st ch.

Round 3: Sl st to next space, (ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in space for corner, *ch1, 3 dc in next space, ch1, in next corner space work 3dc, ch 3, 3 dc*, repeat * to * twice, ch1, 3dc, ch1, join to top of starting ch3.

To work additional rounds, sl st to next space. In corners work (3dc, ch 3, 3dc). In spaces on sides work 3dc. Work a ch 3 in between the dc clusters on the sides.

Do 16 rounds and finish with one round of single crochet in each stitch in white. For the square with the colored middle. I did 7 rounds of color and 9 rounds of white.

Finishing

Pull up a stitch at one end of a square and put 1 single crochet in each stitch. Repeat for 18 rows. Line up the bottom of the 2 squares.

Chain 16 and single crochet in the 2nd stitch from the hook and in each stitch across. Repeat rows of single crochet until you have the length you want for the sides and handle. I did 244 rows.

Slip stitch the long piece to the bottom piece and then the 1 side of the bag. Lay out the length you want for the handle and attach the other short end to the other side of the bottom of the bag. Then attach the last side.

Weave in all ends.
