

Easy Coral Gradient Crochet Throw Pattern

Supplies <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• Tapestry or yarn needle• H – 5 mm crochet hook• 4- 10 oz (283 g) Red Heart Super Saver Ombre Yarn in Sea Coral or any gauge #4 worsted weight yarn 482 yds (440 m)	Abbreviations – US Terms <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>ch/chs</i>– chain/chains• <i>sc</i>– single crochet stitch• <i>dc</i>– double crochet stitch• <i>st/sts</i>– stitch/stitches
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Coral Gradient Blanket Pattern Tips

- The chain is a multiple of 3 + 2.
- Turning chain counts as the first stitch of the row.

Abbreviations – US Terms

- *ch/chs*– chain/chains
- *sc*– single crochet stitch
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Approx. blanket size: 48 in x 64 in

Chain 134

Row 1: sc in the 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Chain 3 and turn.

Row 2: (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in 4th st. *Skip 3 chs, (2dc, ch 1, 2dc) in next st*. Repeat from ** across until 3 sts remain. Dc in last. Chain 3 and turn.

Row 3: (2dc, ch 1, 2dc) in each ch 1 space across. Dc in last stitch. Chain 3 and turn.

Repeat Row 3 until you have 89 rows or the length you want. Chain 1 and turn on the Row 89 or the last one.

Row 90: single crochet in each st across.

Cut and knot yarn. Weave in ends, using a tapestry needle.
