

Seafoam Striped Crochet Baby Blanket

• Scissors • tapestry needle • N, 9 mm crochet hook • 2– 10.5 cakes of Bernat Baby Blanket Yarn Dappled – Aquamarine or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn (440 yd)	Abbreviations – US Terms • ch– chain • dc– double crochet stich • bpdc – back post double crochet stitch • fpdc – front post doublecrochet stitch • st– stitch
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front post double crochet stitch – yarn over, insert the hook behind the post from the front across the post and through the other side, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on your hook, yo, pull thru remaining two loops on your hook. back post double crochet stitch – yarn over, insert the hook from the back of the post, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on your hook, yo, pull thru remaining two loops on your hook. For more info [here](#), from yarnspirations.com.

You can make a larger or smaller blanket by using an even number for the chain. Turning chain counts as first stitch of the row.

chain 90

Row 1: **Dc** in 4th **ch** from hook and each **ch** across, turn.

Row 2: **ch 3, dc** in each **dc** across, turn.

Row 3: **ch 3, dc** in 1st **dc**, ***fpdc** in next dc, **bpdc** in next **dc***; rep from *. Repeat ** across. **dc** in top of turning chain, turn.

Row 4: **ch 3, dc** in each **dc** across, turn.

Row 5: ch 3, dc in each st, across, turn.

Repeat Row 3-5 until you have 41 rows or the length you want.

Cut and knot yarn. Weave in ends, using a tapestry needle.
