

Blushing Stripes Baby Blanket Crochet Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
• Scissors • tapestry needle • 10 mm crochet hook • 2-10.5 oz Bernat Baby Blanket Yarn in Rosie and white or any other super chunky weight yarn	• yo – yarn over • sc – single crochet • hdc – half double crochet • dc – double crochet stitch

You can make a larger or smaller blanket by using a multiple of 3 for the chain.

Chain 60

Row 1: In 2nd chain from the hook sc and in each chain across. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 2: In 1st st **hdc, dc**, skip 2 chains and in the next work **sc, hdc, dc**. Skip 2 chains and repeat “**sc, hdc, dc**” into the next space. Repeat across to the end and there is one chain left. Work 1 **sc**. Chain 1, turn.

Row 3: **hdc** and DC into the top of the **sc** you just made. Skip over the **dc** and **hdc**, *“(**sc, hdc, dc**)” into the **sc***. Repeat the pattern across ending the last stitch with one single crochet. Chain 1, turn.

You’ll always be looking for the **sc** to do your “(**sc, hdc, dc**)” into.

Repeat row 3 until you have used all the yarn. End with 2 complete rows of the last color and a row of single crochet. Cut yarn, weave in ends.
